Age: Warm, responsive and consistent connections with children are crucial for their learning, development and wellbeing. As a parent or caregiver, it can be challenging to know when and how to develop that connection. It can be helpful to think of it as a series of small, meaningful moments instead of one big thing. As children grow, showing genuine interest in their thoughts, playing together, emotional support, routines, boundaries and consistency can boost their selfregulation, social skills and resilience. When they enter pre-teen and teen years, making a few communication tweaks can help build trust and keep relationships strong. Try to have realistic expectations, listen actively, validate their feelings and spend quality time together.
